Starks Lucretia Turner Susana Kimball Walter Starks Annie Starks Lela Starks Rufus Starks Luther Starks. and Ellen Starks. I give and bequeath to the above named nine children equally the half of my Mills Carding Machines & not given to my wife the Mills Carding Machine & is to keep themselves in good running order before there is any division of the proceeds and that my Lands and other property not disposed of by this will shall be sold at public Auction and after paying my just debts the remaining proceeds of such sale be equally divided between the above named nine children but shall any or either one of my children attempt to take or set aside this will he she or they shall not have but be void and of no effect.
